

Minutes of Meeting of Long Sutton Parish Council

1. Parish Plan

Madam Chair invited Mr. Sensier and Mr. Harding to go through the final stages of the Parish Plan. The Councillors present had the opportunity to go through the document page by page with Mr. Sensier and Mr. Harding.

Prior to the meeting, Councillors that were not present gave their opinions of the final Plan. One Councillor suggested that this should be dismissed altogether, but others felt that it was a very good document and that the Parish Council should proceed with it.

There were positive suggestions with regard to pictures and some slight re-wording to make sure the document followed on throughout. There were also a few alterations, but on the whole the final read was agreed on.

Mr. Sensier said he had made enquiries with regard to printing costs and these would be in the region of £1,000 for 500 copies. It was felt that this was a good quote and extra copies would be a good idea.

Suggestions for the launch of the Parish Plan look set for the middle of October. Madam Chair will look into the availability of the Village Hall.

Madam Chair thanked Mr. Sensier and Mr. Harding for all their hard work in bringing the Parish Plan to its final stage.
